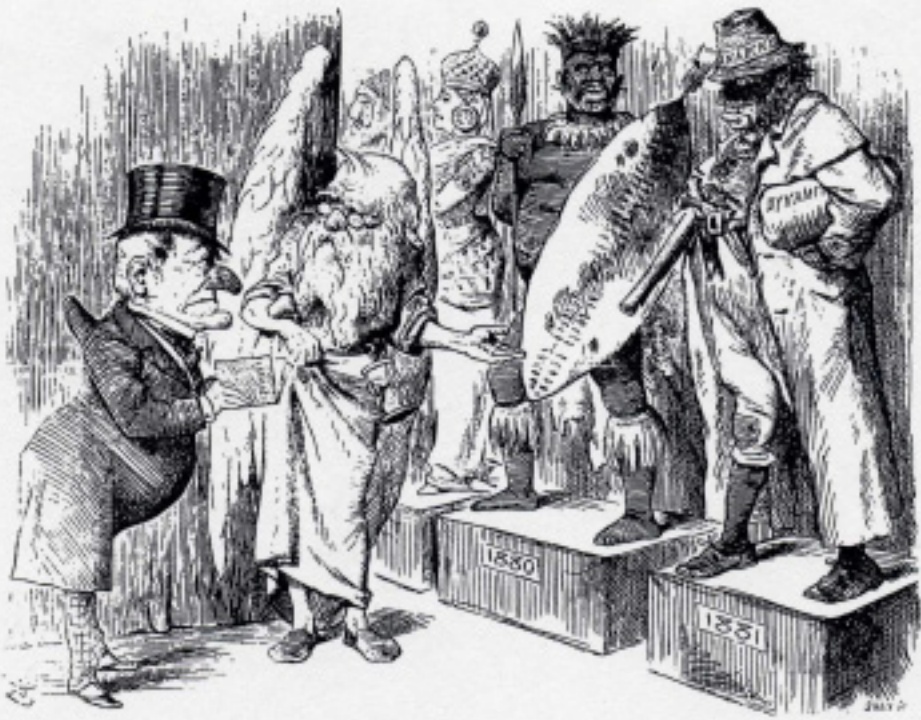

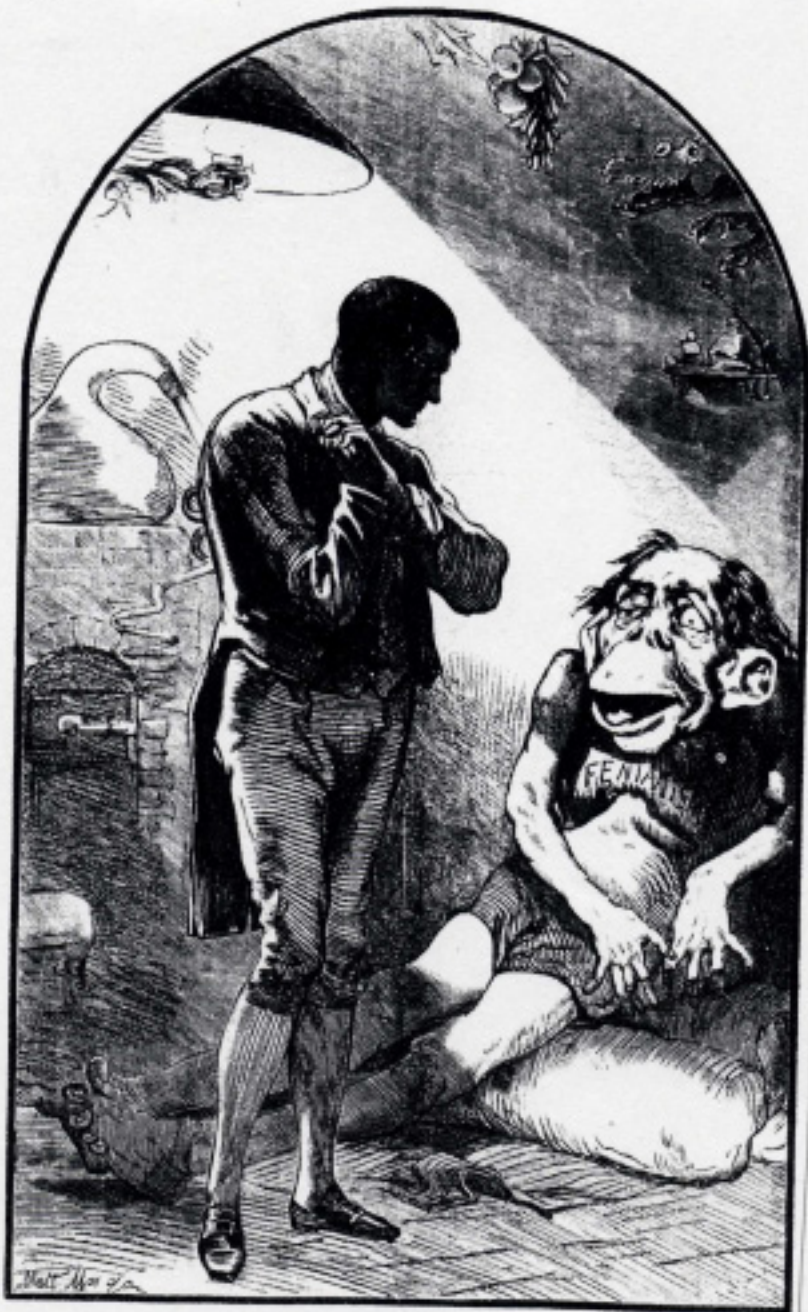


THE IRISH FRANKENSTEIN.

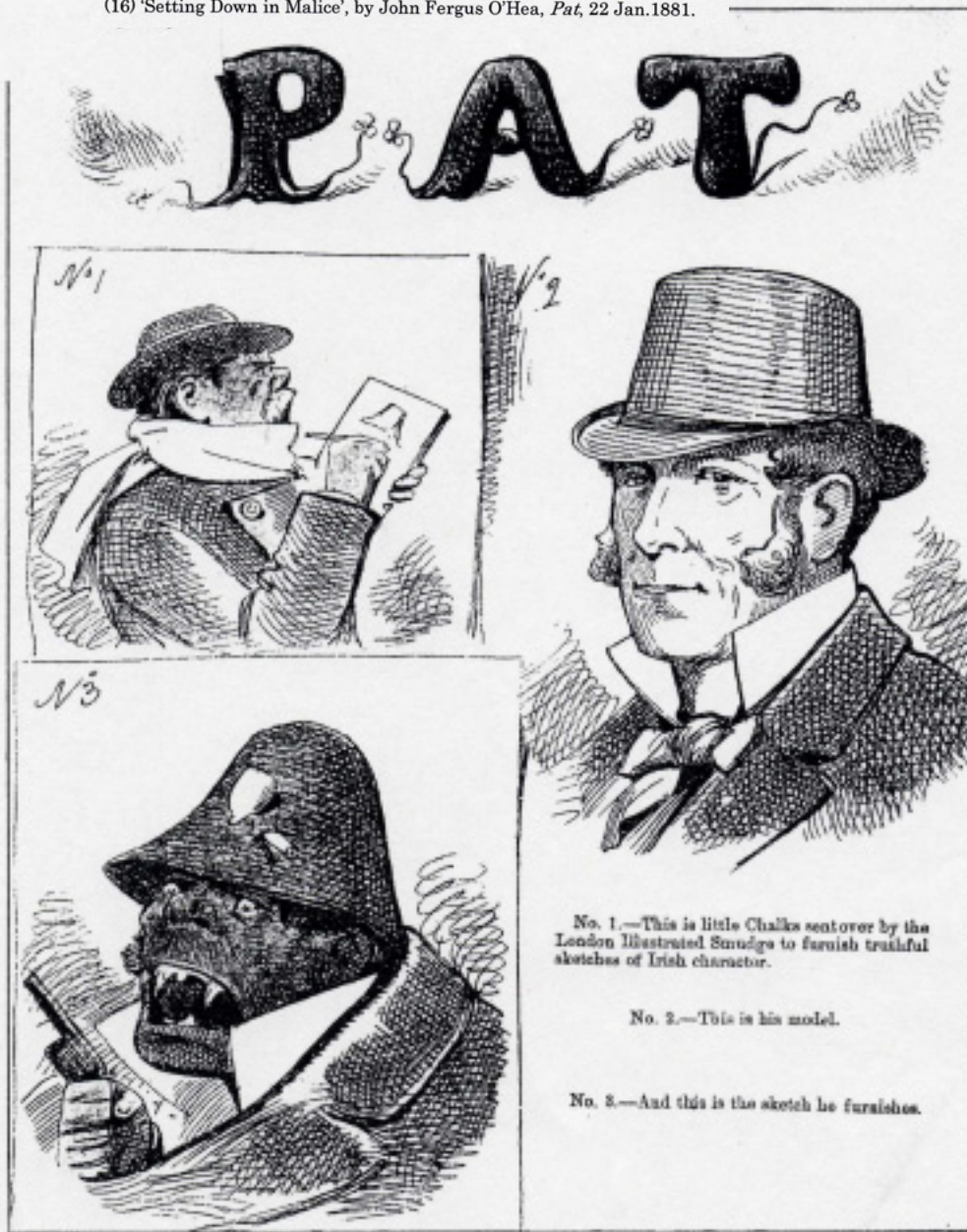
